It is further both Examiners opinion, which is based upon the Polygrams received by this Examinee is that,


Tyra Patterson did try to pull Angela Thuman away from the victims car at the time of the robbery.

Tyra Patterson did not leave with LaShawna Keeney, Kelley Johnson, Joseph Letts, and Aaron Moten, after Michelle was shot.


Tyra Patterson was not friends with Angela Thuman, LaShawna Keeney and Kelley Johnson.
