The following constitutes a confidential report of the interview and polygraph examination of Joseph Letts. The examination was conducted at Motel 6 in Davenport, Iowa on 2/26/2013 at 7:00PM.

**CASE INFORMATION**

The information I used to conduct this examination came you and Mr. Letts.

**PURPOSE OF THE EXAMINATION**

It was the understanding of this examiner, that this test was an effort to determine whether or not you saw Tyra Patterson participated in the robbery and shooting of a female in which she was arrested for.

PRE-TEST INTERVIEW
